WHAT IS HELP WANTED?

Help Wanted is an online program that aims to provide people with a sexual attraction to children with skills and resources to support their commitment to keep children safe and improve their well-being.

You are able to join this study if you:

- Identify as a cis or trans gender man
- Are 18 years or older
- Have a sexual attraction to children 14 years or younger
- Never had a contact offense with a child
- Never accessed the Help Wanted Program
